Oklahoma City- Wrapped in bright colors with the Pops logo and a bottle with effervescent colors, the Pops mobile kitchen will visit local events to offer tasty food and drinks.

Go to the counter and imagine yourself back in the 50's with a soda fountain and hand dipped ice cream being blended into thick and creamy milkshakes. The mobile kitchen serves a variety of outstanding road trip fare. From salads that feature crispy chicken, hickory smoked bacon, cheddar cheese and fried okra, to gourmet hamburgers, or chicken fried steak, Pops Mobile Kitchen dishes up classic on the road favorites.

Doing its part to protect the environment, Pops equipped the Mobile Kitchen to run on Compressed Natural Gas. One of the cleanest burning fuels, natural gas vehicles produce, on average, 70 % less carbon monoxide, 87 % less non-methane organic gas, and 87 % less NOx than traditional gasoline powered vehicles according to naturalgas.org.

Opening in 2007, Pops is located on Route 66 east of Edmond and sports a giant 66 foot Pops soda bottle complete with straw. The signature Pops Soda Bottle with LED lighting has fast become an icon of the Mother Road. With a 50's style diner, over 500 different sodas, and fuel for your ride, Pops is a destination for fun.

A Good Egg Dining Group was started in 2000 when Keith and Heather Paul opened Cheever's Café on 23rd and Hudson. They followed with Iron Starr Urban BBQ in 2002. Both are unique restaurants housed in charming historic Oklahoma City structures. In 2007, the Pauls opened their third restaurant, Red Prime Steak. The upscale restaurant is located in the historic Buick Building on 4th and Broadway in Downtown Oklahoma City. They opened Market C, a gourmet take-out and catering restaurant, in the fall of 2008. . Pops joined the team in August of 2007. This 50's style stop on historic Route 66 east of Edmond offers over 500 flavors of soda pop, gas, quick shop items, as well as a full service café.
